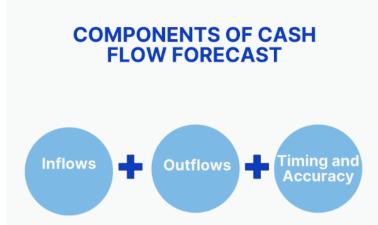

Cash Flow Forecast

Business Value of Cash Flow Forecasting

 Provides organizations with a clear view of expected:

- Cash inflows
- Cash outflows
- Over a defined period



This enables proactive financial management

Business Value of Cash Flow Forecasting

Improved Liquidity Management

Ensures the company maintains sufficient cash to meet obligations, reducing the risk of insolvency or costly short-term borrowing.

Enhanced Decision-Making

Supports strategic planning for investments, debt repayment, and operational spending by predicting future cash positions.

Risk Mitigation

Identifies potential shortfalls early,

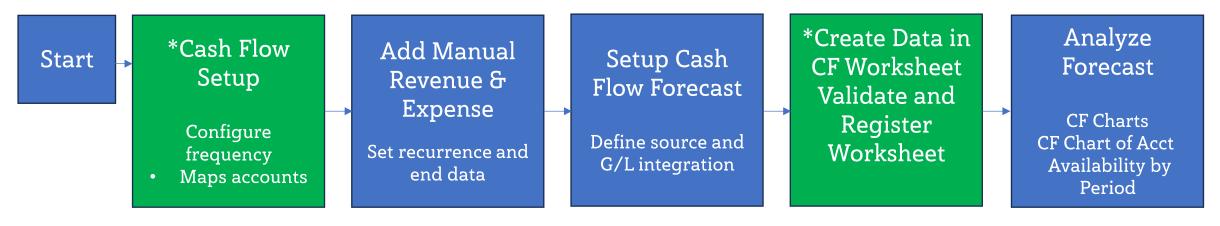
allowing corrective actions such as adjusting expenses, securing financing, or accelerating receivables.

Cost Optimization

Helps avoid unnecessary interest expenses and penalties by aligning cash availability with payment schedules.

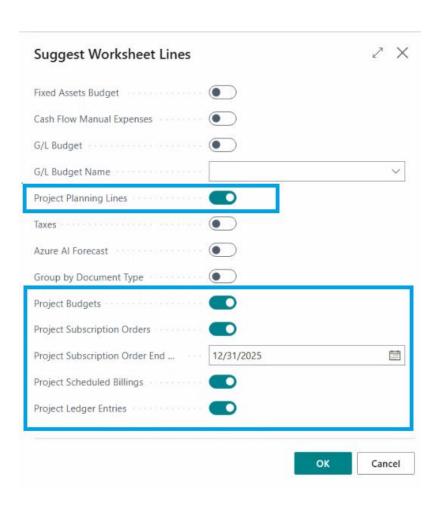

Overview - Cash Flow Worksheet

- Used for planning of Cash Inflows and Outflows
 - Incorporates BC data
 - Standard BC Projects has ability to include planning lines
- Changes to add Progressus scenarios
 - All Progressus Scenarios are only Inflow
 - Include Progressus planning lines
 - Add more scenarios for Progressus data
 - More scenarios can be added in the future based on customer requests

Cash Flow Worksheet Scenarios

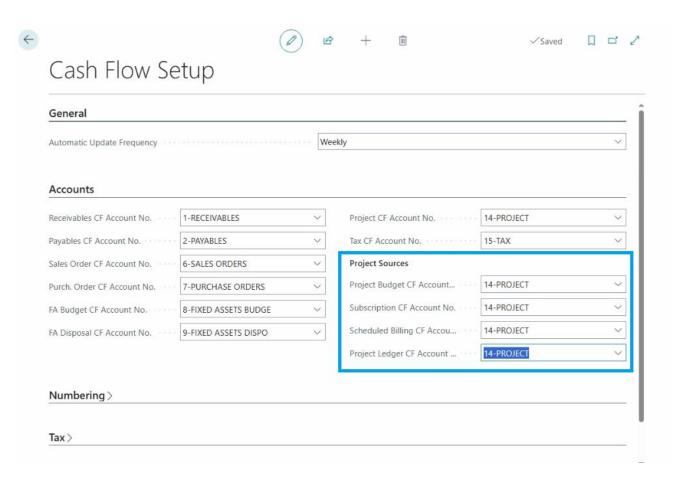


Overview - New scenarios to worksheet All Scenarios are Inflows based on Price

- Forecast Cash inflows based on
 - Progressus Planning lines are included
 - Project Budget Price
 - Chargeable entries only
 - Scheduled Billings budgets are included
 - Subscription Orders
 - Unposted Subscription Order
 - Scheduled Billings
 - Only unposted Scheduled Billings (recurring is included)
 - o Posted but not invoiced are not included
 - Project Ledger Entries
 - o Price only
 - Chargeable entries only
 - Based on Remaining amount of open TM project ledger entries

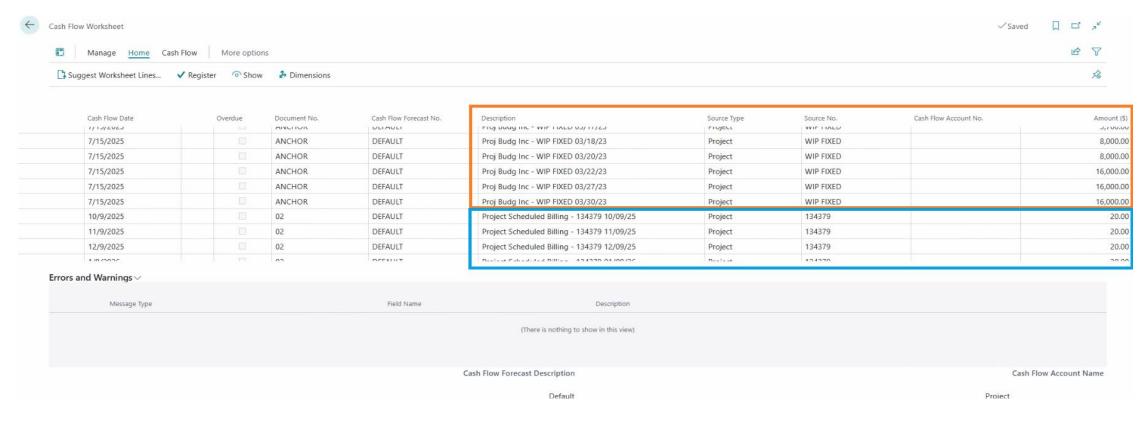
Cash Flow Setup

Use Case Scenarios

- Add planning lines to project and forecast future income
- Create budgets on your project and forecast all project revenue based on your budget prices
 - Note If multiple Progressus options are selected:
 - If you have budget and planning lines for the same data, then the amounts will show under both scenarios
 - If you use Scheduled Billing + Budget Scenario, then the amounts will show under both scenarios
- Identify your future cash inflow based on your existing subscription orders
- Leverage your unbilled posted project ledger entries to identify future cash inflow

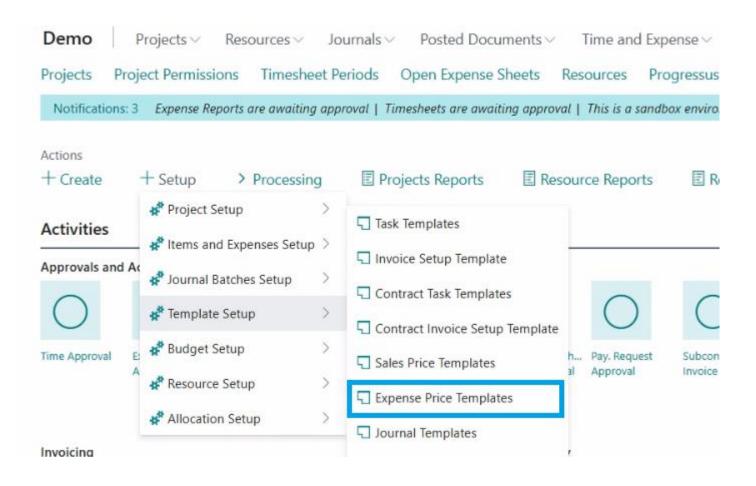
- Expense price template

Expense Price Template

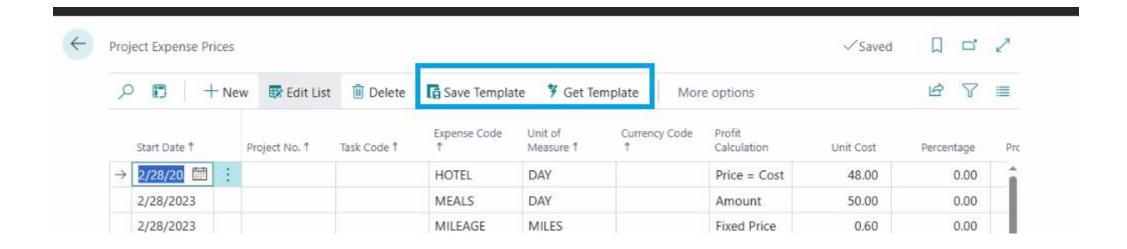
Expense Price Template Business Value

- Global rates for all expense codes
 - Markup 20% of cost for all expenses
- Improves efficiency of setting up prices
 - Customer specific rates create template to be used during setup for projects for that customer
- Increases accuracy of your prices
- Re-use existing prices
- Works similar to Resource Price Template

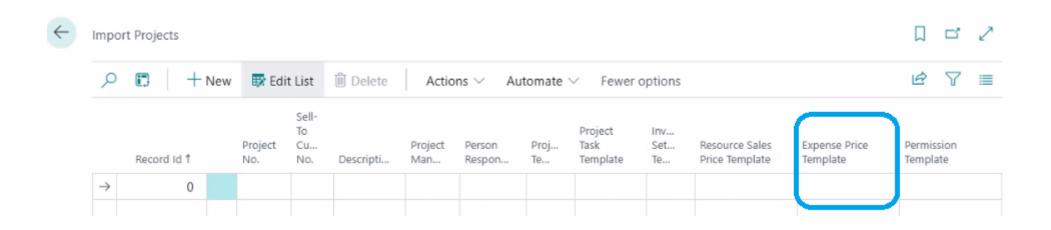

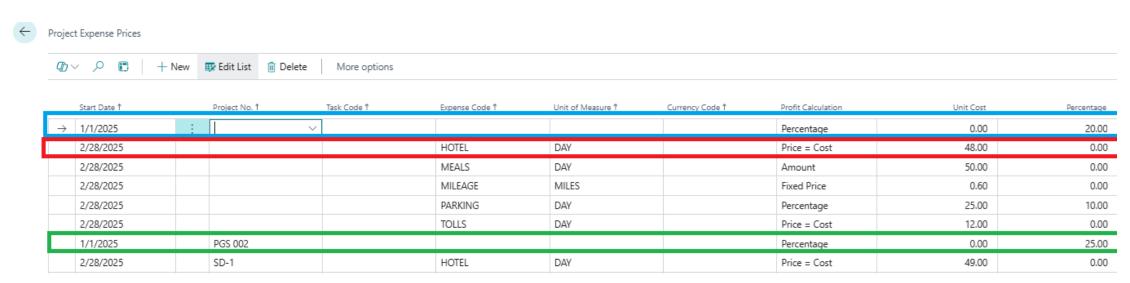

Expense Prices without Exp Code Business Value

- Have a rate the applies to all expense types
- Have rate that applies to all expense type for a project
- Example
 - Apply 25% markup for all expenses
 - Apply 30% markup for all expenses for project PGS 003
